
ARTICLES – MEDIA ITEM CREATE

The purpose of this section is to provide guidance for creating a Media Item Article.


PREAMBLE

An **Article** is designed to augment pages with related information. In the example below, the About page has an Article to left (LATEST COURSE) this Article contains information that relates to another Page namely, Courses.



About Page with Article

The Article (LATEST COURSE) has a link associated with Read More button which in turn will link to related page as illustrated below:



Article link to related page

The rationale applied to 'Page to Article' association is ... when I create a Page I want to consider if I should create an Article so that it can be placed on another Page on the website. Applying this rationale to the Example used in respect to the Home page. A website visitor when on the Home Page is made aware of the Latest Course by the Article. Clicking More Information, routes the visitor to the Courses Page - therefore the LATEST COURSE Article relates to Courses.

This is **dynamic content** and <u>can</u> be updated by the administrator using the CMS.

TYPES OF ARTICLES


There are two categories of Article:

- Menu Item Article positioned on the side of a Page (Left or Right)
- Page Element Article positioned underneath.

For each category there are several formats of Article that are defined individually below:

MENU ITEM ARTICLE

Article_Text_Box - an example of this format is shown below:

Article_Thumbnail - an example of this format is shown below:





Article_Large_Image_Link - an example of this format is shown below:




This is **dynamic content** and <u>can</u> be updated by the administrator using the CMS.

This is **dynamic content** and can be updated by the administrator using the CMS.


Article_Person_Profile - an example of this format is shown below:



This is **dynamic content** and <u>can</u> be updated by the administrator using the CMS.




Media Item Article under Disclaimer Page




TUTORIAL GUIDANCE

- A. Log in to CMS (Administrators Only)
- B. Select Articles option from the Navigation Bar or Site Content panel as shown below:

FORM CONTROLS

The form controls are defined as follows:

- 1. Title (search by) every Article has a Title
- 2. Article Type (search by) Type of Articles are listed above
- 3. Record Type (search by) Pages where an Article can be included (defined below)
- 4. To View an Article and its properties
- 5. Close the Function when Finished
- 6. To Create a New Article


RECORD TYPES

Articles can be applied to 3 specific Page Types:

- a. Page any Page on the website
- b. Home only on the Home Page
- c. Custom specially customized Page


CREATE NEW MEDIA ITEM ARTICLE

D. Click on New Article button and Select Page Element Article (for Articles that are positioned underneath Page). NOTE: ignore Offer Details Fields. Complete the form below Selecting Media Item for Select Article Format and Click Load Article into Preview Window.

E. Sample Complete form and Article loaded into Preview Window:




Completed Create Article Form
